Your Weekend Adventure

- The main event on the Saturday will be a trek up into the hills above Dunkeld, with a What3Words competition along the way. Take your time and enjoy the drive, stopping for a picnic lunch en route.
- When you arrive at Dunkeld Park in the afternoon, you can try a range of activities, including quad treks, forest convoy drives and fun family bushcraft sessions for adults and kids.
- On Saturday evening, enjoy our 'Campfire Sessions' with live music and fire pits a chance to gather, chat, eat and enjoy the sunset. Camp under the stars or book a local hotel if you prefer a solid roof over your head!
- On Sunday, try your hand at vehicle games, let the kids drive off-road with our Young Off-Roader Experience, take part in the blindfold driving competition, enjoy trials demos and tackle our vehicle obstacle course.

Sleeping and Eating Under the Stars

There will be free camping at Dunkeld Park for those taking part in this Adventure Trek Weekend and you are welcome to bring your own tent or caravan, or book into a local hotel if you'd prefer.

If you choose to camp, there is a portaloo and fresh water on site, but this is essentially wild camping – there is no electric hook-up and no chemical waste disposal facility. Please take all waste and litter home with you.

We will be working with our excellent catering partner, Bonnie Mountain, to make sure that delicious food is one of the highlights of the weekend. The weekend price includes coffee/tea and breakfast roll on arrival on the Saturday morning and there will be catering available to purchase throughout the weekend. You are welcome to bring your own food if you prefer and we advise guests to bring a picnic for the trek on Saturday so you can take the chance to stop and enjoy the scenery!

Price

The price for the weekend is £250 per vehicle with no extra charge for additional passengers. Bring family and friends to share the fun!

This price includes the off-road adventure trek, camping/caravan area, all Saturday and Sunday activities except quad treks which will be available at half the usual price. The price also includes Saturday morning refreshments at Butterstone Loch, but no other food or drink; catering will be available to purchase throughout the weekend or you are welcome to bring food with you.

Essential Information

Under The Stars is open to all Land Rovers, and you will be driving your own vehicle throughout the weekend.

We would advise you to take out off-road insurance for your car. Vehicles must be taxed and fit for purpose, with good tyres, and be suitable for on-road as well as off-road driving. Side steps and body kits are not advised due to the risk of grounding out. Tow balls should be taken off although this is not always practical; if so there will be a risk of grounding out.

All gates must be left as they are found, and no fires or BBQs are permitted except for the main campfire at Dunkeld Park. All waste and litter must be taken home with you.

You are welcome to bring family or friends with you in your car, as long as everyone is wearing a seat belt at all times. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead whenever they are outside your vehicle.
